

Roadworks are starting in your area soon.

What's happening, where and when?

What: Carriageway resurfacing and installation of road markings

Where: Buckingham Road, Wicken

When: Monday 26th February 2024 – Saturday 9th March 2024 (Weekday working only)

Traffic Management: A diversion will be in place between 20:00 – 06:00, as shown on the map overleaf. The **RED** line shows the road closure, and the **BLUE** line shows the diversion route. A closer image of the closure extents is shown to the right.

How long: 10 nights, 20:00 – 06:00, (Road will be accessible as normal outside of working hours).

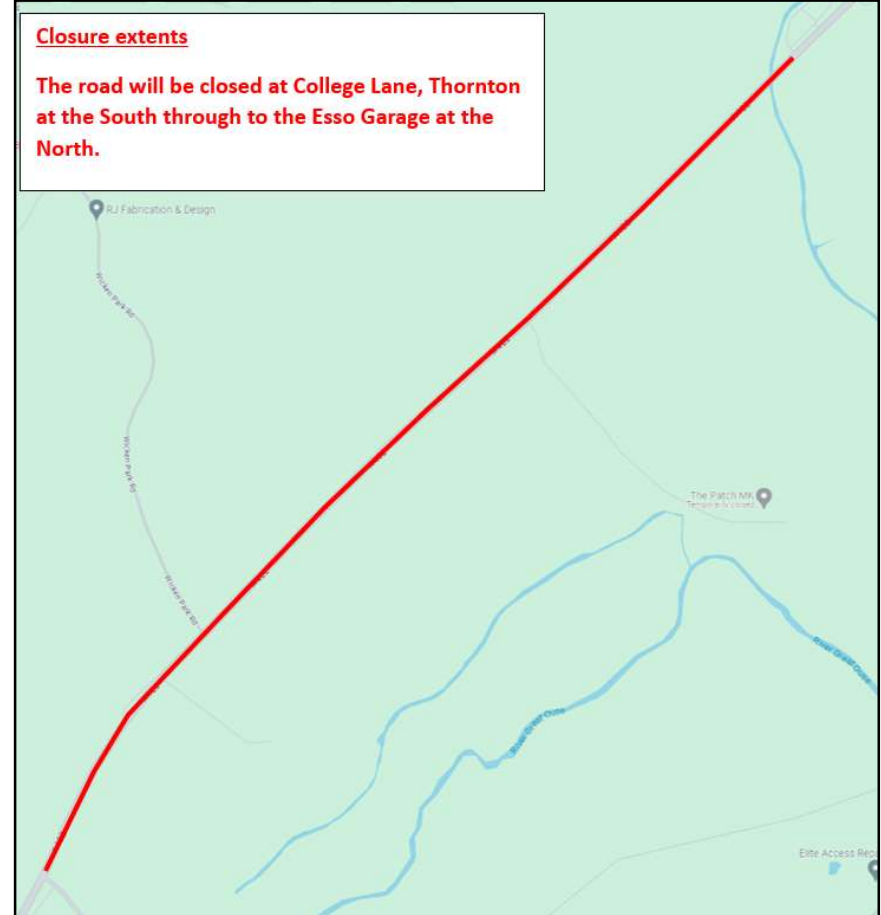
Emergency Vehicles: Access will be maintained where possible, however please expect delays.

Residents/Businesses: The road will be closed from the Esso garage to College Lane. Access for residents/businesses within the closure will be maintained where possible. However, prolonged delays are to be expected. There will be no access through the closure for any businesses/residents outside the closure extents.

Signs will be installed at the entrance to driveways/businesses (see example of sign to the right) along with cones and barriers. Please ring the number on the sign for access and one of the team will assist you. Please do not enter the closure until one of the team has arrived to assist.

Our works involve resurfacing across business/residential accesses. For a short period, access will be restricted while the asphalt sets. Thank you for your patience and cooperation.

Public Transport: There will be no bus services through this closure during the working hours.



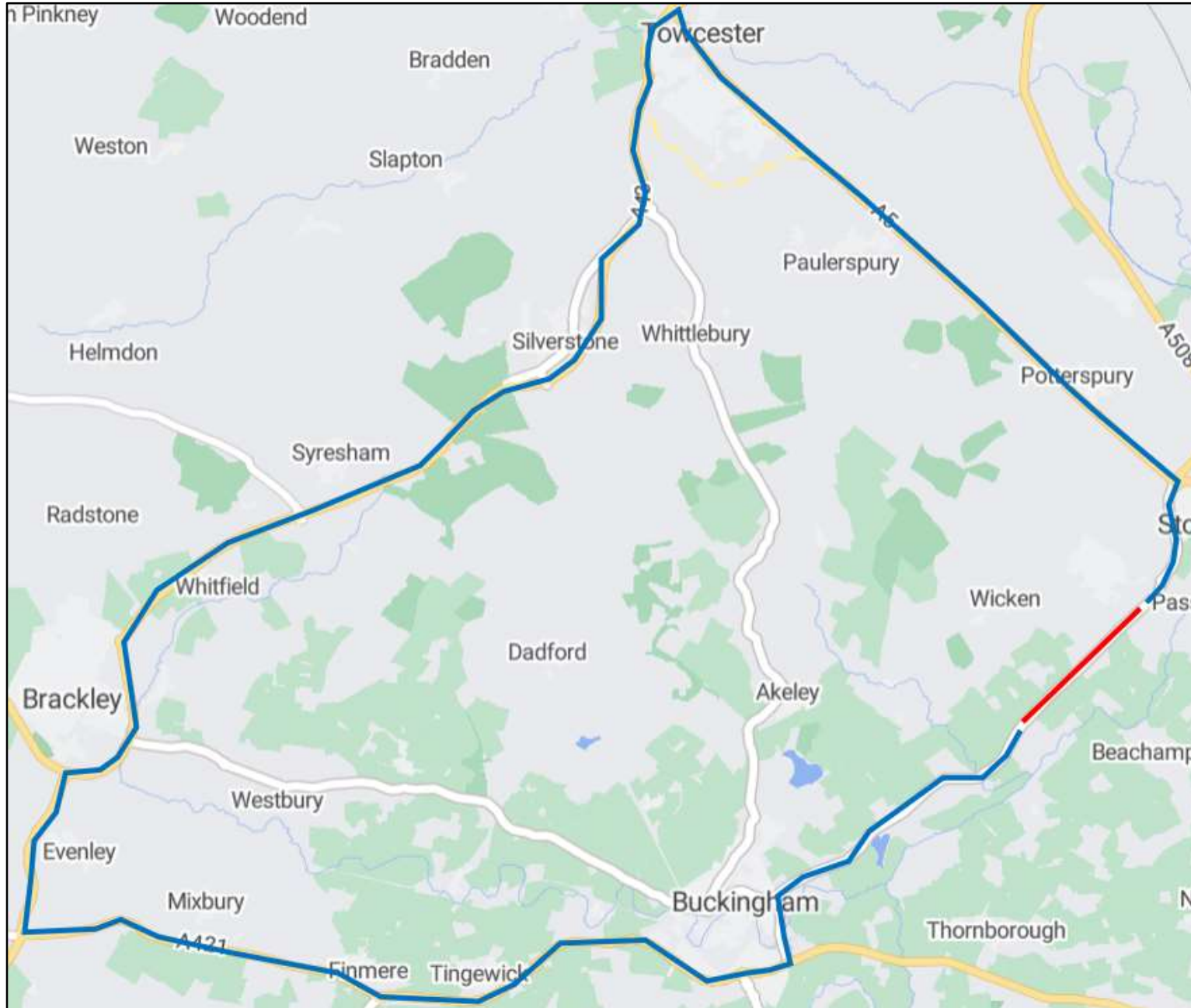
